



PHILLIPS HILL 2007 CORBY VINEYARD PINOT NOIR ANDERSON VALLEY

Vineyard: Northern Anderson Valley in Philo, CA. Planted in 1995 along the east side of the Navarro River. Here the vineyard lies in the direct route of the fog channel from the Mendocino coast on gentle sloping rolling hills. This vintage is the first single vineyard designate from this vineyard and may be the last due to sale of the property. Enjoy this unique opportunity while it lasts.

Harvest: October 4th 2007

Clones: 50% Pommard, 50% Dijon 115

Brix: 24.5, 23.8

Tons per Acre: 3

Alcohol: 14%

pH: 3.62

TA: 6.5

Barrel: 100% French Oak, 11 months, 40% New , 20% 1 year, 40% seasoned.

Fermentation: Whole berry, 6 days cold soak 16 days on skins.

Cases: 350 cases. Unfined and Unfiltered.

Notes: True Anderson Valley, Elegant in color, medium bodied with scents of dark cherry , rasbery, beetroot, earth and oak. Fruit forward with floral violets. Delicate but flavorful with dark cherry, long finish of balanced oak and acid.
