PHILLIPS HILL 2010 CHARDONNAY ANDERSON VALLEY

Vineyard: Ridley Vineyard, owned by Jack and Peggy Ridley in Boonville, Anderson Valley. A total 2 tons of Chardonnay from their 2 acre vineyard shared with the 777 Pinot Noir.

Harvest: October 15

Clones: Dijon 96

Brix: 23.6

Tons per Acre: 3

Alcohol: 14.0

pH: 3.51

TA: 6

Fermentation: Whole cluster pressed off to Stainless Steel , NO OAK. Sur lies and stirred every 3 weeks.

Cases: Bottled March 30th 2011 100 cases.

Notes: Dry, Medium bodied, with expansive nose of apples, pears, meyer lemons, lemon thyme. Pine and honeysuckle ending in lemon custard. Flavors of ripe grapefruit, jonagold apple and fresh ginger finish. Fruit is intertwined with the smooth round mouthfeel.

Pairings: Mild fresh herbs, with some kind of fat component be it dairy, fish, meat or buttery olive oil. Smoked trout, chicken, charcuterie with a citrus component.
