



PHILLIPS HILL 2008 BEESON TREE ANDERSON VALLEY

Vineyards: A Blend of Corby Vineyard 37.5% and Toulouse Vineyard 37.5%
Oppenlander 25% Beeson Tree, def; Everything is fine; in the language of Boontling.

Harvest: Corby - October 9 & 15, Toulouse - October 1, Oppenlander – October 9,12

Clones: Corby 50% Dijon 115, 50% Pommard, Toulouse 667, 115, 777, 2A
Oppenlander Pommard, 115, 114, 667, Martini

Brix: Corby - 24, 23.7 Toulouse - 24.5 Oppenlander - 24

Tons per Acre: 2.5

Alcohol: 14.0%

PH: 3.7

TA: 5.3

Barrel: 100% French Oak, 11 months, 40% New , 20% 1 year, 40% seasoned.

Fermentation: Whole berry, 4 days cold soak 8-14 days on skins.

Cases: 400 cases. Corby & Toulouse, eggwhites fined, Unfiltered and Untreated.

Notes: Medium bodied with scents old world Queen Anne and Red cherries, bright raspberries, cedar. Earthy smoke with red and black licorice lingering with ginger.

Pairings: Classic Burgundian game, organ meats, mushrooms, red currant in glazes or garnishes. Chaource cheese.
